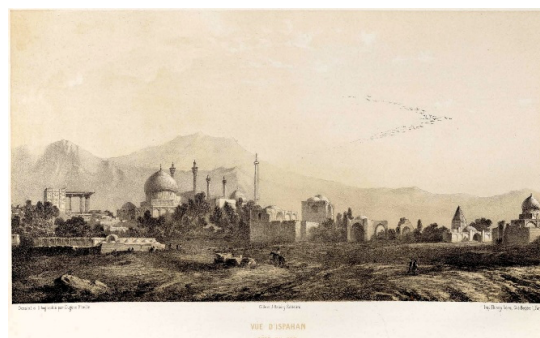

Bio: András Barati is a post-doctoral researcher at the Austrian Academy of Sciences, affiliated with the project *Entangled Charters of Anatolia (1200-1300)*. He earned his PhD in Iranian Studies from Eötvös Loránd University in Budapest, where he specialized in the study of medieval and early modern Persian state documents. His dissertation on archival documents from the Āstān-i Quds-i Rażawī of Mashhad received summa cum laude. His research focuses on Persian diplomatics and the administrative history of the Persianate world. He authored the monograph *Exercising Authority and Representing Rule*, published by Brill.
