

## Mapping academic solidarity with Palestine

We are mapping the experiences of academics who have attempted to organise over the past month in response to what is currently happening in Palestine. We are aiming to systematically document:

- What has been attempted (organising talks / events/ statements of solidarity)
- What support you have received in the initiatives you have attempted, and at what level (student led; departmental; institutional)
- What obstacles you have faced in the initiatives you have attempted, and at what level (student led; departmental; institutional)
- Any changes in the learning environment of your students (e.g. changes to the learning space, increased security presence, required changes to the curriculum or the content of your teaching, etc.)
- If relevant, anything you are willing to share about the support or criticism you have received personally as a result of your work on Palestine
- What the response of the student body in your institution has been to the current situation
