Dear Nicola Pratt,

Thank you for your letter dated 17th June regarding a call for further funding for the higher education sector.

I'm proud that our universities and colleges have all stepped up in the fight against Covid-19 and their contribution to research, innovation, skills and employment will be vital for our economic recovery as a nation. However, we do not yet know for sure the impact the pandemic and public health measures will have on the size and shape of domestic and international student demand this autumn. The scale of the financial challenge that universities are facing is significant and may be beyond devolved administration budgets. We welcome further discussions with HM Treasury about this to maintain the strength, stability and strategic direction of our sector as a whole.

I have recently published a higher education policy statement (<u>https://gov.wales/higher-education-policy-statement-coronavirus-html</u>). This statement outlines what the Welsh Government is doing to support universities and students dealing with the effects of Coronavirus. It outlines some of the actions we are taking to support financial pressures, such as providing an indicative annual grant to HEFCW, and bringing forward SLC tuition fee payments to institutions so that a greater than usual proportion of funding is available in autumn.

We also welcome the UK Government's announcement on 27th June of additional support for research. However, we would prefer that such funding be allocated to the devolved administrations in order to maximise the support we can provide to the higher education sector in Wales.
